

Kink Party Dress Code & Etiquette Checklist

Print it. Tick it. Pack the bag the night before — not twenty minutes before the rideshare.

Dress code — safe default

- ☐ All black: fitted top or bodysuit
- ☐ Black pants, skirt or shorts
- ☐ Boots or closed-toe heels
- ☐ No jeans, hoodies, sneakers, logos or jerseys

Level up (fetish nights)

- ☐ Latex dress, leggings or top
- ☐ Leather harness, corset or cuffs
- ☐ Mesh, PVC, fishnets
- ☐ Collar (only if you know what it signals)

Glory hole night

- ☐ Bottoms easy to adjust — no laces
- ☐ Boots you can stand in for 2+ hours
- ☐ No trailing sleeves, capes or snag risks
- ☐ Anonymous mask if the theme allows

Theatre takeover

- ☐ Full fetishwear — go harder here
- ☐ Statement footwear (heels, platforms)
- ☐ Coordinated with your +1 if attending as a pair

Bag to bring

- ☐ Photo ID (18+ checked at door)
- ☐ Coverup for the walk in/out
- ☐ Wet wipes + deodorant
- ☐ Water bottle
- ☐ Cash for cloakroom & tips
- ☐ Phone charger
- ☐ Small towel (theatre + glory hole nights)

Leave at home

- ☐ Strong cologne or perfume
- ☐ Anything with sharp studs on soles
- ☐ Loose jewellery that snags
- ☐ Cameras of any kind

Etiquette — non-negotiable

- ☐ Ask before you touch. Every time.
- ☐ “No” and “not tonight” are complete answers
- ☐ Phones stay in bags — no photos, no video
- ☐ Never interrupt or cross a scene
- ☐ Names inside the venue stay inside the venue
- ☐ Find a host or dungeon monitor if something feels off
